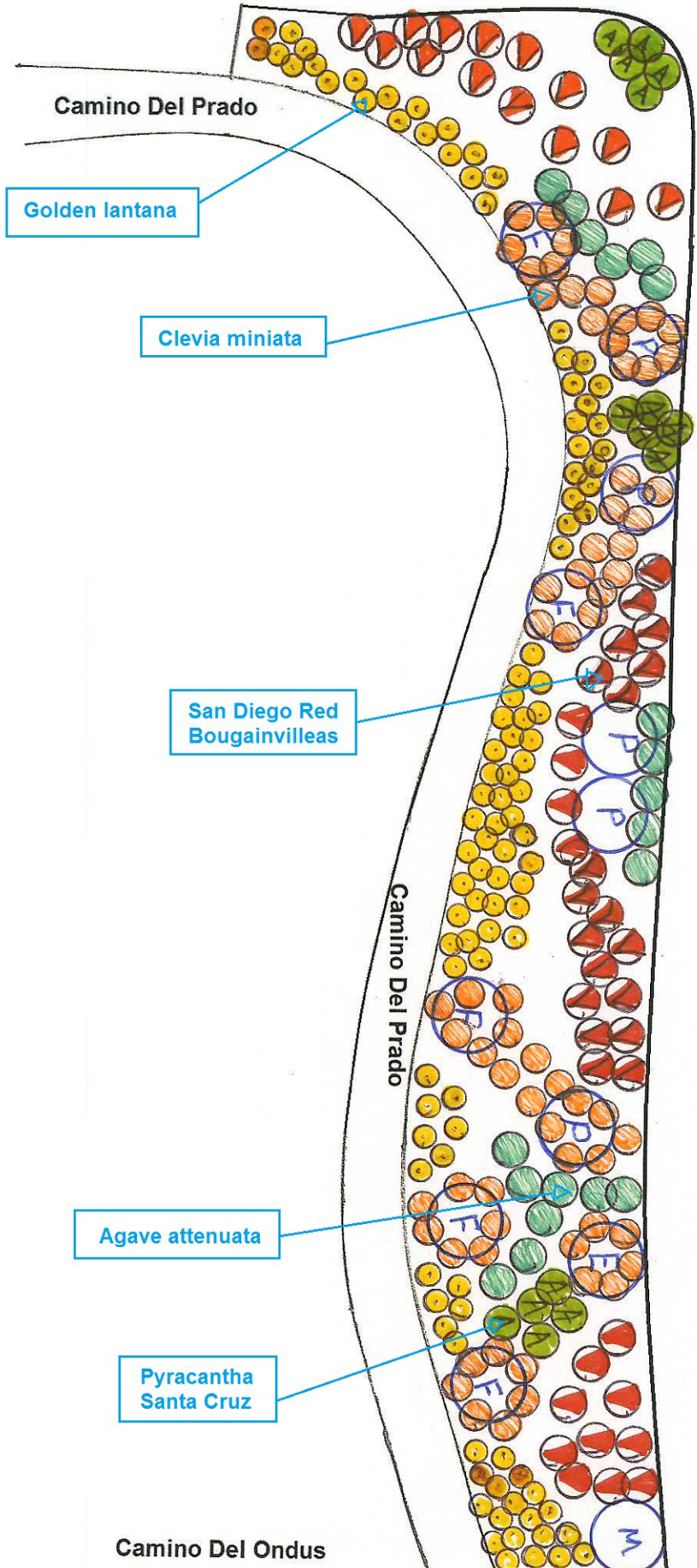


Sketch for grass renovation at slope along Camino Del Prado

San Diego Red Bougainvillea

known as San Diego Red, the strong vining habit of Scarlet O'Hara provides quick cover and beautiful show of amazing clusters of deep magenta-red flowers. Can be used as summer annual in cold climates in slopes, containers, hanging baskets. Evergreen.



Clivia miniata

Clivia miniata is a species of flowering plant in the genus *Clivia* of the family *Amaryllidaceae*, native to damp woodland habitats^[1] in South Africa. It grows to a height of about 45 cm (18 in), and flowers are red, orange or yellow, with a faint, but very sweet perfume.
